

David Bowie May Have Died From Liver Cancer

David Bowie, the legendary rock star who died last week of cancer at the age of 69, managed to keep the exact nature of his illness a secret from all but a few people close to him, [The Independent reports](#). However, a friend of his claims Bowie had liver cancer.

Last week, Belgian theater director Ivo van Hove, who worked with Bowie on *Lazarus*, a new stage musical based on his music, told the website [dutchnews.nl](#) that the star revealed to him that he had liver cancer a little over a year ago as an explanation for why he was not able to attend rehearsals for the show. Bowie's producer, Tony Visconti, also recently suggested that the artist knew for a year that his cancer was incurable, calling his last album *Blackstar* a "parting gift."

Rumors of Bowie's health had been circulating since at least 2004, when the star collapsed after coming off stage in Germany, where he was later taken to a hospital and underwent emergency heart surgery.

Many have pointed to Bowie's long-time smoking habit and heavy drug use, which he sang about extensively in the album *Cracked Actor*, as other potential reasons for his passing.
