



# France Secures Lowest Price for Sovaldi in All of Europe

France has negotiated a huge discount for Sovaldi, Gilead Sciences' new drug to treat the hepatitis C virus (HCV), [Reuters reports](#). The new deal will ensure that the treatment is fully reimbursable by the country's health-funding schemes.

Officials say France has secured "the lowest price in Europe" for Sovaldi (sofosbuvir), with a 12-week course of treatment priced around 41,000 euros (\$51,373), a reduction of nearly \$18,000 from the drug's original price.

In the United States, a full course of Sovaldi treatment costs about \$84,000, which comes out to almost \$1,000 per pill.

It is estimated that some 200,000 people in France are living with hepatitis C, with the total cost of treatment at around 800 million euros a year.
