



# I have hepatitis C and chronic kidney disease. Is hep C treatment hard on kidneys?

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Hepatitis C is associated with an increased risk of chronic kidney disease (CKD). Treating hep C may reduce this risk. Although medications in general can be hard on the kidneys, most of the drugs used to treat hepatitis C are safe.

The decision of which drugs to use is based on genotype and the stage of your kidney disease. Zepatier or Mavyret are recommended for people with advanced CKD.
