



My doctor prescribed hepatitis C treatment, but my insurance won't pay for it. What can I do?

Coverage for hepatitis C treatment varies regardless if a private insurer, state plan, or federal program pays your health care costs. Despite the individual differences, all plans have procedures in place to help you appeal denials.

Start by working with someone who knows how to navigate the system. HEPmag.com provides a list of [patient advocacy programs](#), such as the Patient Advocate Foundation's [Hep C Careline](#). You can also call [Help4Hep](#) and ask them for assistance: 877 Help 4 Hep (877-435-7443).
