



# The new hepatitis C treatments sound easier to take than the older ones. Are there still a lot of side effects?

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Generally, the new hepatitis C direct-acting antivirals are much easier to tolerate than the older interferon-based treatments. The likelihood and intensity of side effects depend on what hepatitis C treatment is prescribed. If ribavirin is included, then people typically notice more side effects. When ribavirin isn't prescribed, some people have few or no side effects.

For whatever reason, some people just seem to experience more side effects even with the easier to tolerate treatments. Fatigue is the most common issue.
