



I am starting hepatitis C treatment. Should I stop taking milk thistle?

Milk thistle derives its medicinal benefits from its active ingredient, [silymarin](#). Milk thistle [does not interact](#) with any of the [direct-acting antivirals](#) commonly used to treat hepatitis C.

Although milk thistle doesn't interact with medicines used to treat hep C, you may want to stop taking it because independent lab analysis by ConsumerLab.com found that nearly all the milk thistle sold in the United States falls below clinical standards. In other words, there wasn't much of the active ingredient silymarin in the product. Also, despite the claims, milk thistle may not do much to help the liver.
