# Immunizations and Hepatitis B

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The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommend that all people with chronic liver disease be vaccinated against [hepatitis A](#) if they are not already immune. Coinfection with hepatitis A can lead to severe liver disease in people who already have hep B. The hepatitis A vaccine consists of two doses within a six-month period.

Be sure you are up to date on all immunizations. In addition to the recommended vaccines for adults, flu shots are recommended for patients with liver disease. Discuss immunization guidelines with your doctor to be sure you are up-to-date with the latest recommendations. To find vaccination locations near you, talk to your doctor.
