Fear works against you, not for you. Fear hinders your healing and treatment for Hep C. Like the domino effect; fear breeds worry and creates stress, stress suppresses the immune system, which affects your liver. Fear and worry paralyzes us from moving forward into all God has for us. Fear and worry are the danger zone in which a defeated mentality takes hold.

From there we are caught up in downward spiral of hopelessness. When we open the door to fear, we turn our backs on faith. We say with our actions, God we don't trust you. That's a very dark, dangerous place to be. All of us deal with fear on some level. The difference is what we choose to do with it when it wants to move in and unpack. Don't open the door when fear knocks!

Fear starts with a spark and before we know it, we're engulfed with overcoming flames of worry that consume us.
