The heat helped me to cut out half of my daily dose of painkillers. Coming off the painkillers has left me with restless leg syndrome though. I caught a bug on the plane home so I've been laid up for the last 5 days. During the last 5 days I've been either paranoid that the virus has come back or I've been wondering if I will always feel like this. However I'm better today and I can feel a new energy.
