- Glutamine is a powerful amino acid that can help to heal leaky gut syndrome. If you are having autoimmune or inflammation in your body, it may be helpful to heal your gut.
- Healthy weight is a good indication that you are living in a body that fits your lifestyle, mobility, and stamina. Add protein with bone broth to feel full and satisfied without empty calories.
- Get some sleep with the glycine that is naturally occurring in bone broth. A warm cup of soup for dinner should set you up just right.
