- "Jesus You Reign above all things."
- "Jesus, hold me close."
- "Lord, Jesus, I need you now."
- "Jesus, never let go."
- "For this I have Jesus is my daily rally cry."
- "Jesus, break these chains."
- "Jesus, help me see from your eyes today."
- "Jesus, give me your Holy courage and renew my hope"
- "Jesus, I need your strength in abundance"
- "Jesus, show me the work of your mighty hand."
- "Jesus, breathe your spirit and peace on me today."

Max Lucado in his book, "*Before Amen*," shares this wonderful truth, "You're never without hope, because you're never without prayer."

God's Words tells us in Romans 10:8-10, "The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is the word of faith we are proclaiming: That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.
