Here are some simple, but powerful messages you can use:

- More Americans die from hepatitis C than from HIV. Get tested, get treated, get cured!
- One in 30 Americans born between 1945-1965 is living with hepatitis C. Get tested, get treated, get cured!
- Every day, more than 53 people in the US die from hepatitis C; it's time to change this. The CDC recommends one time hep C testing for everyone born from 1945 through 1965
