Write a letter to the editor of your local paper about the need to raise hepatitis awareness. Here  are some key points you can use:

- More people in the U.S. die every year from hepatitis C than die from HIV
 - The hepatitis C death rate is increasing annually
 - The number of new hepatitis C infections is increasing at alarming rates, particularly among teens and young adults
 - Despite the increase in new hepatitis C virus (HCV) infections, there has been a decrease in the prevalence of HCV in the U.S. because so many are dying
 - The CDC recommends testing all person born from 1945 through 1965 for hepatitis C
 - Hepatitis C infection is preventable and curable
 - The majority of those with HCV don't know they have it; you can't treat hepatitis C without a diagnosis
