"Today is day 88 of week 13 in my treatment for Hepatitis C. There are days when you feel so ready to stop in your tracks and say, "I'm done." But the truth is, to get beyond Hepatitis C you have to persevere through every phase even when you don't feel like it!

I have discovered exactly why the doctor warned me about the effects of summer heat while on treatment. It's a super charged zapper! I've felt awful on every level this week.

Life goes on even when you're feeling bad. The lesson I've discovered while on treatment is, pace yourself. Stop, rest, give yourself a break (in every way), don't get tied in knots emotionally because you're having a bad day or week. You will get beyond this!

In order to get to the other side of victory you have to cross some rough terrain, hang in there, persevere and keep going. You will make it!

For me, this week is about persevering and being in the waiting room. Persevering because I've felt physically felt awful, and I'm waiting to get my blood test results. This will be my next RNA (virus load count) and liver enzymes, CBC, thyroid, etc...

I've been praying for the Lord to help me except whatever this test shows with strength, courage, perseverance, faith and trust. When I was praying about the results, I felt a whisper to my heart say, "Trust." I knew shortly afterwards when I was reading my Bible, the scripture in [John 14:1](#) jumped off the page at me and God was asking me to take His hand and trust Him, no matter

what.
