The biggest thing I've noticed is energy goes up and down, like riding a wave. You never know how long it's going to last. I know each day I'm getting further down the road to recovery, God will bring the right amount of energy designed for each day.

My doctor told me last week I had an excellent chance of the Hepatitis C virus never coming back. Getting back to normal after Hepatitis C treatment does not happen overnight but progress is being made daily.

I've learned to focus on the weekly victories. Keeping your focus on your gains rather than losses keeps you looking up and forward. You can't move forward while looking in the rear view mirror. Keep your eyes on the recovery road in front of you. It makes a difference.

Here's the happy news for this week. Progress on Post Hepatitis C Treatment for Week 2:

1. Appetite is still off but slowly coming back. I'm able to "taste" food again, yeah!
2. Thrush is clearing up and tongue soreness is almost healed.
3. Skin sores are healing.
4. Hair loss has slowed down considerably.
5. Sleeping has improved.

I'm thankful Treatment for Hepatitis C is over. Love that word. . . OVER!!!

Here's a nugget that jumped off the page when I was reading this morning. It was a pat on the back and a boost to my spirit that "this too shall pass," and to remember, the Lord brings us to a better place and never lets us go.
